Think about how learners will engage with the instruction.



Does the instruction provide options that can help all learners:

- regulate their own learning?
- sustain effort and motivation?
- engage and interest all learners?


Think about how information is presented to learners.



Does the information provide options that help all learners:

- reach higher levels of comprehension and understanding?
- understand the symbols and expressions?
- perceive what needs to be learned?

Think about how learners are expected to act strategically & express themselves.



Does the activity provide options that help all learners:

- act strategically?
- express themselves fluently?
- physically respond?
